

## Golden Bears Squeak By Aggies to Advance Unbeaten

Tampa, FL – Cal-Berkeley Club Baseball defeated Utah State by a score of 14-13 on Sunday night at The University of Tampa Baseball Stadium.

The match-up was set to begin at 3:15 the same afternoon, but a morning rain delay pushed the tournament schedule back two hours for a start-time of 5:15 p.m.

The Golden Bears got hot in the second inning and put up three runs on three hits and one error. That same inning, the Aggies took advantage of the momentum and scored two of their own on two hits and three errors.



Heavy rain swept through the Tampa area again in the third inning, and the match-up was delayed for fifty minutes. As the clouds cleared, the fourth inning finally resumed at 7:55 p.m.

The Aggies put up a quick two runs in the bottom of the fourth, but Cal was red-hot after the long delay and went on to score a combined 10 runs in the fifth, sixth and seventh innings. After seven complete, the Golden Bears had a comfortable lead of 13-6.

But as the clock ticked on, the Aggies found their stride and made quite the comeback to rattle Cal. Utah State scored three runs on three hits in the bottom of the eighth and looked ready for more.

Cal notched one more run in the top of the ninth and it proved to be a clutch one as the Aggies mounted a four-run comeback in the bottom of the inning. The Golden Bears won the evening match-up by one run, 14-13.

Cal-Berkeley is now 2-0 in tournament play and will continue on to play at 7:30p.m. on Tuesday, May 27<sup>th</sup> against an opponent yet to be determined. Utah State will face the University of Florida in an elimination game on Monday, May 26<sup>th</sup> at 3:15 p.m.
